

SIDE LETTER Between

STATE OF MARYLAND ("Employer" or "State")

And

AMERICAN FEDERATION OF STATE, COUNTY & MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES, MARYLAND COUNCIL 3 ("Union" or "AFSCME")

This Side Letter will confirm the agreement of the parties that effective November 1, 2025, bargaining unit employees identified in Attachment A, employed by Maryland State Police in the Automotive Services Specialist and Automotive Services Supervisor classifications will no longer be eligible to receive Hazardous Duty Pay, Article 7, Section 6, for performing brake inspections, brake work or suspension work, so long as the brake pads and materials remain asbestos-free.

Further, the parties agree that bargaining unit employees employed in the classifications below on November 1, 2025 shall receive the following:

- Maryland State Police Automotive Services Specialists, Grade 11 shall receive a one-time three (3) step increase; and
- Maryland State Police Automotive Services Supervisors, Grade 12 shall receive a one-time two (2) step increase.

For bargaining unit employees who are at or near the top step for their grade, the step increase shall be applied to the extent permitted under the current salary schedule. If the full increase (2 or 3 steps, as applicable) cannot be applied due to salary range limits, the employee shall receive the maximum number of steps available, which may be fewer than the full increase.

Any other pay increases, including step increments or cost-of-living increases, shall continue to be applied in accordance with the employee's hire date, subject to General Assembly's passage of the budget.

Additionally, this Side Letter does not adversely impact the ability of the current or new employees performing this work in these classifications to request physical exams due to exposure or potential exposure to harmful agents or toxic materials, etc. under Article 38 of the MOUs for Units A, B, C, D, F & H and Unit S.

This Side Letter is hereby accepted by the parties on this day, October 25, 2025.
